Team wins championship

Team Walker, which curls out of Broomstones Curling Club in Wayland, won the Grand National Curling Club (GNCC) Region's Junior Women's Division Championship at the Utica Curling Club on Dec. 31. With a final record of 7-0, Team Walker will move on to the USCA Junior National Championship at the Granite Curling Club in Seattle, Wash., in February.

Team leader Monica Walker began her curling career in 1997 and has since led her team, including Jillian Walker, Laura Hallisey and

Nikki Rossetti, to some major accomplishments. This is the team's third consecutive GNCC championship title, which is essentially the eastern title, as GNCC encompasses all curling clubs in New England and the mid-Atlantic.

In 2005, Team Walker placed fifth in the U.S. Junior National Championships, and in 2006 they won the silver medal. A gold medal this year in the National Championships will lead them to the Junior World Championships.

The team is sponsored by Wayland-based BELA-Olhão sardines and tuna.
